For starters

Which of these is the biggest challenge for you in prayer and why?

Distractions, listening, finding the time, motivation, doubt, focus.

Study

Read Romans 8:26-27.

Paul is writing to the Roman Christians and in chapter 8 he reminds the believers that they have life through the Spirit and that this same Spirit helps them in their sufferings and their weaknesses.

- 1. What do we learn from these verses about how the Holy Spirit helps us to pray?
- 2. How does it change how we view prayer to consider that the Holy Spirit intercedes for us?

Read Ephesians 6:18 and Jude 1:20.

- 3. What might it mean to 'pray in the Spirit'?
- 4. Ellen used some personal examples of how she allows the Holy Spirit to lead her praying including:
 - prayer times with no agenda and seeing where it leads
 - listening for nudges and promptings
 - praying in tongues
 - active listening in the silence

Do any of these resonate with you or do you have other examples to share?

Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-5.

Paul encourages the believers to speak in tongues (v1, v5) and he reminds them that this is a prayer language (v2) and is for personal edification (v4).
